September 21 (Monday)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ FALL QUARTER CLASSES BEGIN! ➤ CCS Employees, Washington State Public Employees tuition waivers (as space available). No signatures required September 21st; instructor signatures and Division dean signature required September 24th – 25th ➤ Beginning with Fall 2020, the class waitlist process will be discontinued evening of the first day
September 22 📢	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Last day to add classes online in ctcLink or in-person without instructors' signature/permission
September 23 - 28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Instructor signature required to add classes even if space is available ➤ Division dean AND instructor signatures required for full online classes ➤ Senior Citizens tuition waivers (as space available). No signatures required September 23rd; instructor signatures required September 24th & 25th
September 25 📢	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Last day to receive 100% refund for reducing credits or withdrawing from FALL Quarter
September 26 – October 12 📢	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 50% refund period for reducing credits or withdrawing from FALL Quarter ➤ NO TUITION REFUNDS AFTER OCTOBER 12
September 28 – continued	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ To ADD a class: Instructor signature AND Vice President of Instruction permission required. Refer students to the Late Enrollment Form on the SCC website to electronically obtain VPI permission. ((Dynamic Dated or OEE (open entry/exit) enrollment classes may be added without instructor signature until the first day of class)) ➤ Division dean, instructor AND Vice President of Instruction approval is required for full online classes
October 2 (Friday) 📢	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Financial Aid Census date ➤ Last day to drop classes to prevent "W" being posted on transcript
October 3 – November 9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Dropping classes will post "W" on transcript
October 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Financial Aid priority date for new WINTER Quarter 2021 students. Students who submit documents after this date may be awarded on a funds-available basis. The Financial Aid Office cannot guarantee that awards will be available by the tuition due date

November 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Current student registration for WINTER Quarter begins for students with 30 or more credits
