as since whether

because that, so that which, whichever

before unless while

Group B: The *FANBOYS* (coordinating conjunctions—join two **independent** clauses together:

for and nor but or yet so and the semicolon

Group C: TRANSITIONAL words—words that can add some class to the beginning of an independent clause:

however furthermore nevertheless therefore

on the other hand thus

instead consequently

meanwhile
